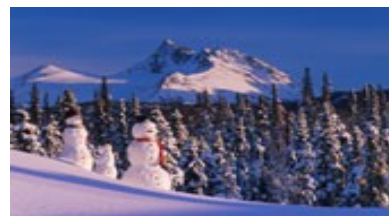

New Year's Eve Ball Drop... In New York City, a large, illuminated 700 pounds of iron and wood ball was first lowered from the Times (New York Times) Tower flagpole at midnight to signal the end of 1907 and beginning of 1908. The ball has been dropped every New Year's Eve since then except for 1942 and 1943 due to the wartime "dim-out" of lights. The ball's materials have changed throughout the years, dependent on technology, and was redesigned by Waterford Crystal for the 2000 celebration. A worldwide audience now watches the ball-lowering ceremony, and the ball drop has become the world's welcome to the New Year...

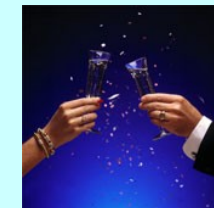
